What are the programme objectives?

The IFB Next Generation Leadership Programme, which is based on best practice from leading business school MBA and executive education courses, will provide insights and skills that are highly relevant to you as an emerging leader in a family business.

Participation will equip you with practical tools as well as a support network, both of which will be invaluable as you develop your leadership role. Through peer-to-peer learning you will have the opportunity to practice skills and learn from people who face similar challenges.

The programme focuses on organisational behaviour – the ‘people’ side of leadership and each of the five individually themed modules incorporates theory, skills practice and in-depth discussions. You will:

- gain an understanding of leadership and the progression from manager to leader
- develop your ability to manage the tripartite roles of family, ownership and management
- enhance self-awareness; understand your strengths and weaknesses as a leader
- develop an understanding of family dynamics applied in the family business context

By the end of the programme you will have:

- a better awareness of your own leadership style – including your strengths and weaknesses
- the relevant skills for effective leadership in your organisation
- a heightened sense of readiness for the family business challenges that lie ahead
- a group of peers that will provide you with an invaluable support network, both during the programme and throughout your career.

Programme outline and learning aims:

Module 1:

Your leadership challenge - the role of personality

Your personality is a very important dimension of your leadership style. In this session you will learn to identify and manage your strengths and weaknesses.

- Improve leadership and management skills by gaining self-awareness
- Understand the differences in leadership when working with family and non-family

Module 2:

Difficult management interactions

Learn the essential skills of emotionally intelligent leadership. Using real life examples, you will explore and apply concepts such as decentering, motivation, influencing and coaching.

- Gain a practical understanding of emotional intelligence in the family business system
- Learn how to give feedback effectively and understand the impact you have on others

Module 3:

Family Dynamics

You will assess your own family climate, and learn the essentials of family psychology.

This is fundamental to understanding the interface between family and business in the family business system.

- Learn how to identify patterns in business families, and how they can be effectively managed
- Understand your own family relationships and how they affect the business

Åsa is a trained psychologist specialising in family business, and has extensive experience working as an executive coach. She has taught at London School of Economics and published internationally acknowledged research on family business dynamics.
